Supported Housing

IN KENT

We have three move on houses in Kent. They are available to people who have completed a suitable recovery programme and need a place to live with support in order to sustain their recovery, relaunch their lives and reintegrate into the community. The length of stay is generally up to 2 years.

We offer regular support through key working and weekly house meetings with the project manager, help with daily living skills, accessing training or volunteering opportunities and signposting to other agencies.

We address the 7 pathways:

- Accommodation Support
- Education, Training and Employment
- Health and Wellbeing
- Drugs and Alcohol
- Finance, Benefits and Debt
- Children and Families
- Attitudes, Thinking and Behaviour
