The Yalding site is located half way through Kenward Road, between Wateringbury and Yalding.

By train

The nearest station is **Wateringbury** (1.1 mile), on the Southeastern line between Paddock Wood and Strood. Please note that there are no taxis at the station and that being a country lane, there is no footpath.

From London, there are a number of train options taking up to 1 hour and 15 minutes, and a change will be needed to get to Wateringbury. Trains from Charing Cross / Waterloo East / London Bridge require a change at Tonbridge or Paddock Wood, and trains from St Pancras International (High Speed) need a change at Strood. The nearest direct train is from London Charing Cross / Waterloo East / London Bridge to Paddock Wood, taking about 40 to 50 minutes.

By car

Use of a sat nav is recommended.


From the motorway M20 Dover / east bound, leave at junction 4 following signs to Tonbridge until Wateringbury is signposted. At Wateringbury (A26) turn right into Bow Road at the crossroads (traffic lights).

From the motorway M20 London / west bound, you may use either junction 5 or carry on to junction 4 (which is a couple more miles but generally faster at peak times) by following the directions above.

At junction 5 follow the lane signposted Aylesford, and then follow signs to Barming then Wateringbury. At Wateringbury (A26) turn left into Bow Road at the crossroads (traffic lights).

From either direction

Drive down Bow Road and turn left at the train station (the Bow Hill sign is missing). Go over the rail track and the bridge over the river Medway, and carry on straight for 1 mile. The road leads into Kenward Road and you will see the Kenward Trust signs indicating the entrance on the right hand side of the road.



Parking

We have several parking areas. The first car park is close to reception in the Head Office building. There is also a car park further on by Kenward House. And there is dedicated parking at the Conference Centre.
